Course Description: This five-week intensive course is designed for K-12 teachers who desire to learn how to integrate literacy into in the physical education classroom seamlessly in order to benefit both the teacher and the students. This course will help physical education teachers learn what literacy is, its components, the importance of incorporating it for teachers, students, the physical education program, and the school community, and practical strategies to integrate literacy into the physical education curriculum. Through online activities, discussions, and demonstrations, students will gain the knowledge, skills, and confidence needed to achieve this goal. Upon completion of the course, students will develop their own literacy plan and methods of assessment.
