Course Purpose/Description: This course will give students an understanding of the changing scope of secondary physical education (SPE) in an era of education reform. Students will learn about a variety of curricular models and styles. In addition, students will increase their understanding of technology use and authentic assessments in physical education. Students will not only focus on increasing the physical activity levels of secondary students during physical education, they will also learn about promoting physical activity outside of the school setting. This course will also cover strategies for advocating the importance of quality physical education to school and district personnel, during a time when local administrators are pressured to allocate more time to core subject areas.
