Course Purpose/Description: This 8-week course is an introduction to the coaching profession. The emphasis of this course will target coaching at a variety of levels including youth sports, high school sports, intercollegiate sports, etc. The goal of the course is to develop and enhance students' knowledge and understanding of concepts and techniques of coaching and their application to achieving important objectives in working with athletes. The course combines sport science theory and research with the practical knowledge and methods of expert coaches. Principles and practical applications are presented and explained for the various dimensions of coaching. Upon completion and a score of 80% or higher on the final exam, students will receive a National Certification in Coaching through American Sport Education Program (ASEP). The certification is not required to pass the course.
