Course Purpose/Description: This is an asynchronous, online course. Students will receive an email Sunday evening each week with a reminder of the topic of the week, readings, assignments related to the topic including discussion questions and due dates. Students can progress through the readings and assignments at their own pace during the week.

Assignments: 7 major assignments and a final project; including developing an action plan for an Elementary PE program that aligns with National Standards, defending a standards-based curriculum, identifying characteristics of learners, locating level 1 outcomes regarding fitness knowledge, constructing a rubric, analyzing body image portrayals in the USA, designing a fitness/wellness education curriculum based on HOPE units, and "value" challenges for change. Grades: A-F.
