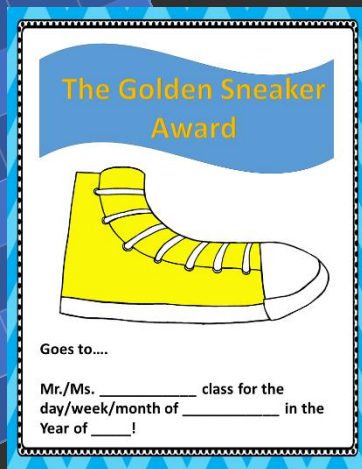


The Golden Sneaker Award Program



- ✓ A program designed to encourage students to wear their sneakers to PE regularly.
- ✓ You get instructions on the program, 2 award types, and 2 chart types to use this in the way the best suits your needs.

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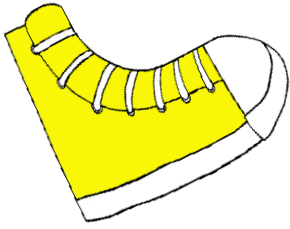
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Golden Sneaker Award

Instructions

This system is meant to encourage students to wear their sneakers on PE day! You can use this in several different ways. Below are some options that work well. You will notice that students start to encourage their classmates to wear sneakers for this program.

Option 1: Use the blue weekly chart to mark every day during the week everyone in a class is wearing sneakers on their PE day or days. Write the names of your classes in the left hand column. If the entire class wears sneakers for every PE class that week, give them the class golden sneaker award. Circle the words that pertain to your situation and fill in the blanks. You can keep track each week and tie it into option two if you choose. Week by week is better for young students in 2nd grade and below.

Option 2: Use the green monthly chart to mark which classes had everyone in the class wear their shoes for an entire month. This may work better for older students in 3rd grade and higher. If a class gets a mark for that month, they get the whole class golden sneaker award. You can use the weekly chart to help keep track of the weeks for the month you are in.

Option 3: If you have one or two students who consistently do not wear sneakers, you can use the weekly or monthly method for that student to encourage them to wear sneakers. Before doing so, ensure the student has sneakers at home and the means to get them. If they wear their sneakers for the week or month, give them the individual golden sneaker award.

Enhance this program by posting these items on a bulletin board or in the gym. You can give a more tangible award with the certificate such as a trophy from the dollar store. You can take a picture of the student or class with the trophy, let them keep the trophy in the class, and put the picture up on the bulletin board or in the gym. Happy teaching!
